



Gift Aid

If you are a UK taxpayer, you can increase the value of your subscription at no cost to yourself. We can then claim back some of the income tax and/or capital gains tax which you have already paid. If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you can also claim back some of the payment for yourself.

Please note that subscriptions paid as Gift Aid are subject to the following:

- 1. You must be a UK taxpayer
2. You must pay an amount of income and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that BAPT reclaims on your subscription in the tax year (currently 24p for each £1 you subscribe)
3. You must sign and date the declaration form
4. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying BAPT
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can reclaim the additional tax in your Self Assessment tax return
6. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that BAPT reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see 4)
7. Please notify BAPT if you change your name and address
