BORROWING ARRANGEMENTS

- Contact the BAPT Library by emailing: **library@bapt.org.uk**
- Members may borrow books from the Library for a period of four weeks and must meet the cost of return postage. BAPT will cover the cost of sending it to you, though in recent years the Library has been available to browse and borrow at the annual Conference.
- Renewals are permitted for one or more further periods of four weeks if you just email the Library.
- Please, *please* return any borrowed books. If you forget and then remember, we would be glad to have them late rather than not at all! Don't hang on to them simply out of embarrassment; they belong to the wider membership.
- Copies of journals and Conference Proceedings are held as Reference Copies only and may not be lent out to members. However, articles in all copies of Typeface back to 1989 are available online. For more details visit <http://www.bapt.org.uk/resources/typeface-archive-online>.
- The Librarian will be responsible for maintaining a record of loans, ensuring books lent are returned and accounted for, and costs incurred.
- The Treasurer will be responsible for invoicing borrowers for the amount due.
